Dear Chief Judge Murguia:

I would like to bring to your attention the above-mentioned report (on flash drive) that I submitted to each of the Justices of the U.S. Supreme Court, and to the following Members of Congress: Speaker of the House Mike Johnson, House Minority Leader Hakeem Jeffries, House Judiciary Committee Chairman Jim Jordan, Senate Majority Leader John Thune, Senate Minority Leader Chuck Schumer, and Senate Judiciary Committee Chairman Chuck Grassley. I also made an ethics complaint against Congressman Sam Liccardo with the Office of Congressional Ethics for his role in this criminal obstruction of justice scandal when he was a councilmember and Mayor of the City of San Jose.

The report makes it clear that the judgment in my lawsuit in favor of the City of San Jose is based on fraud, a violation of the constitutional mandate of the full faith and credit clause that's implemented by the full faith and credit act (28 U.S.C. Section 1738), and flagrant bias by the Ninth Circuit Court of Appeals. The judgment is unconstitutional and unenforceable by law, and is considered void. Yet, my many efforts to have the judgment set aside have been unsuccessful, and the Supreme Court and Congress have, so far, failed to take any action on my report.
